

Title: Quick Draw Olympics!

Grade Level: K-5

Objective: Students will race against the clock to complete quick, spontaneous sketches.



Lesson Plan

Materials: copy paper, pencils/colored pencils/crayons/markers

Opening Activity: Introducing the “QUICK DRAW OLYMPICS!!!” You may want to identify 1 student to be the time keeper/referee/helper: you’ll need help replenishing supplies in between each round. Let students know that they’ll be picking a scenario BY NUMBER from a list and that they’ll have 3 minutes- 3 MINUTES ONLY- to draw in each round.

Core Activity:

- Get your LIST READY (see below!)
- Distribute pencils and 1 small stack (5-10 sheets) of copy paper to each member... call on 1 student to give you a number between 1-5 for the first round, and prepare your timer.
- ANNOUNCE the drawing prompt for the first round, announce it 2 times and then say: “Ready, Set, DRAW!!!” and start the timer.
- Give them a 30 second warning and then count down from 10 before you say “PENCILS DOWN!” then have students HOLD UP their drawing at their seats and come around to see each drawing.
- Choose a new student to give a number 6-10 and prep for round 2!!!

Reflection: As students help clean up the space, ask them: did you like this activity? Why or why not? DO you think ART should be a competition? Should ART be in the OLYMPICS?
